

A. 誘いの導入

Write down three examples of an introduction question.

Way Question	
1	<i>Hey, do you like Indian food?</i>
2	<i>Hey, do you like coffee?</i>
3	<i>do you like dancing?</i>

If the other person says “no,” write down another question you would ask.

Way Other Question	
1	<i>Well, what about Italian food?</i>
2	<i>Well, what about tea?</i>
3	<i>Well, what about music?</i>

B. 誘いの核

If the other person says “yes,” right down the next question to invite someone.

Way	Phrase
1	<i>Would you like to get Indian food with me (sometime)?</i>
2	<i>Would you like to get coffee with me (sometime)?</i>
3	<i>Would you like to go dancing with me (sometime)?</i>

What is the question the other person will ask, after deciding what to do?

Do you know any good places around here?

For each of the three invitations in part B, tell the other person a good place you know.

Place	The good place that you know
1	<i>I know a good Indian food place called (name), it has good Naan!</i>
2	<i>I know a good coffee shop around here. It has good espresso.</i>
3	<i>I know a good dance studio around here. It has good tango lessons.</i>
